CCLASS ACT is an innovative drama troupe where talented kids, grades 7th-12th and both boys and girls, who love the arts join forces to produce some of the best shows in the state. Not only do kids get a superior arts education by being a member of this elite troupe, but also have the opportunity to earn scholarship money for college. Half of all funds earned by the shows that the troupe produces goes into an interest-building fund. When a qualified member of the troupe graduates from high school, their share of what they've earned while in the troupe is awarded to them in the form of a scholarship. You get to earn money for your future education while having fun putting on great shows!

FAQ:

How old do I have to be to be in the troupe?

You must be in at least 7th grade to try-out for the troupe.

How do I get involved in the troupe?

All you have to do is print off the application found on our website, fill it out correctly and mail it in. If you qualify for an audition, you will hear from us by September 14th.

When is the deadline for the application?

All applications must be postmarked no later than September 10th.

When and where will auditions be held?

Auditions will be held at Triumvirate Theatre in the Peninsula Center Mall September 17th.

Can anyone come to the audition?

You must have filled out an application and been invited by Triumvirate Theatre to audition.

What do we do for five days during auditions?

You will be taught dances, songs and be required to master a monologue. After working with the troupe director all week, participants will then have the opportunity on Saturday, October 3rd to audition for the selection committee.

Who makes up the selection committee?

The selection committee is made up of at least three members of the community who are experts in the performing arts. They will make the final decision as to who is selected for membership in the troupe. The director of the troupe does NOT make selection decisions.

How many kids will make it into the troupe?

The bylaws of Class Act limit the size of the troupe to no more than ten members. However, the selection committee may elect to have as few as five.

What if I don't get in? Can I try again?

Yes, auditions for the troupe will be held every year. Also, if there is a vacancy, a special audition could be held during the course of the season.
