and we're **still burning** the **midnight oil** to bring **children's theatre to Nikiski.**

The Triumvirate North Initiative is a three-phase project that will empower the community of Nikiski to bring arts and culture to the North Road. This 3,600 square-foot building is well on its way to becoming the center of culture in Nikiski. **We have a plan...**



Phase One: (COMPLETED IN THE SUMMER OF 2008) Dilapidated fencing is removed, parking lot is graded and general area clean-up initiated.



Building is reinforced with two by six constructed walls, support beams, and plywood sheeting. Interior walls in the front of the building are constructed and plumbing to accommodate rest rooms is roughed in. Furnaces for both the bookstore/lobby and the theatre areas are purchased. Building is sheathed with new vinyl siding for the entire building and new windows and doors are installed. New Triumvirate North sign is also installed.

Phase Two: (THE BOOKSTORE/LOBBY) Internal framing of the lobby/bookstore area complete. Rewiring of the building and installation of new



lighting fixtures, electrical outlets and installation of forced air duct heating system. Plumbing completed and septic system over hauled. Lobby/bookstore area insulated, sheetrocked, painted and other finish work completed. Bookstore to be opened in fall of 2010. Revenue generated from book sales will be applied to phase three.

Phase Three: (THE THEATRE) Heating system installed and rewiring of electrical system in the theatre portion of the building complete.



Insulation added. New lighting fixtures added plus accommodations made for theatre lighting and sound systems. Theatre area stage and seating installed. New doors with panic hardware installed. Stage curtains and furnishings added. First show target date Fall of 2011.

The Vision:

Triumvirate North will be a 120-seat theatre that will host community events, plays, concerts, films, and fundraisers for community members that need help. It will house a bookstore of more than 50,000 books and a gallery of local art, including kids' work. This community facility will be the cultural center of the North Road.
